A. Especially those seeking God's _word_.

B. Just _use_ what you've got.

- II. Play a greater part when it is necessary--
 - A. Especially to get the _word_ out.
 - B. Get back up when you're _knocked_ down

- III. _Recognize_ that you will be greatly misunderstood- -
 - A. Especially when you are committed to God's _word_.
 - B. You may have to _go_ where you don't Jer 45:1-5 want to go.
- IV. _Don't_ _seek_ great things for yourself- -
 - A. Especially when you can be a part of God's greater _work_.
 - B. _God_ has a word for you.
