

SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

The following questions are for discussion in your small group. As disciples, our goal is to obey the Word, not just listen to it preached (James 1:22). Therefore, the questions lean towards application of the biblical teaching we get during the sermon. We hope you are able to consider and answer these questions prior to your group meeting time. These questions may also be good for family discussion times.

1. Review the four universal callings for believers. Do you have any questions about them? Insights?
2. Review the four “practicals to consider” when discovering God’s plan. Answer the following:
 - a) How often are you reading the Word? Why is reading the Bible important in discovering God’s plan?
 - b) In what ways could someone “hear” the Spirit?
 - c) Who would you go to for “Godly counsel?”
 - d) How do current circumstances help you know God’s plan?
3. Share an experience where a strong vision has helped you to become more focused.
