SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

Sermon Questions - 5 Solas - Sola Fide

- 1. Martin Luther famously wrote two words in his Bible summarizing his beliefs: Sola Fide (Faith Alone). What two words or phrase would you use to summarize your beliefs?
- 2. Sola fide is the belief that justification is by faith alone and not on the basis of any good works. How do the following verses support this belief?
 - a. John 3:16
 - b. Acts 16:31
 - c. Romans 3:28
 - d. Philippians 3:9
- 3. What are the differences (if any) between believing faith, the gift of faith, and a growing faith?
- 4. Read Romans 3:21-31 and discuss the following:
 - a. Verse 21 says "the righteousness of God has been manifested (made known)". How do we get it? Why do we need it?
 - b. How does Paul describe what Jesus did when he died? What do these verses tell us about why he died on the cross (v. 24-25)?
 - c. Why do you think being justified by faith mean that "boasting....is excluded (v. 27)?"
 - d. How does believing the gospel and "boasting" in Christ humble us? Enable us to be honest with ourselves? Free us from anxiety? Stop us from fearing failure or death?
- 5. Read Leviticus 16:1-17 and discuss the following:
 - a. What was the high priest of Israel, Aaron, to do with a goat (v. 5, 15-17)?
 - b. In what way was the animal "presented?"
 - c. What did the sacrifices of the bull (for Aaron) and the goat (for the people) achieve?
 - d. How do the details of this passage help us appreciate further what is meant by "God presented His Son as a sacrifice of atonement" in Romans 3:25?
- 6. Optional: Are Sola Fida and James 2:18-26 complimentary or contradictory? Explain.
- 7. End your time in prayer asking the Lord to grow your faith in Him (2 Peter 3:18) and to help with your unbelief (Mark 9:23-24).
