Sermon Questions – 5 Solas - Sola Christus

1. Mixer: Who is your favorite super hero? Why?
2. Solus Christus is the belief that salvation is obtained through the atoning work of Christ alone and that Christ is the only mediator between God and man. It holds that salvation cannot be obtained without Christ. How do the following verses support this belief?
 - a. John 14:6
 - b. Acts 4:12
 - c. 1 Timothy 2:5
3. What are some common objections to Solus Christus? What concerns do you have?
4. Christians are not only saved by Christ but also grow in Christ. Read Colossians 2:6-15 and discuss the following:
 - a. Note the seven different “in him” references to Christ. List each one. What does each imply?
 - b. Why do you think Paul is reminding the Colossian church of what they have in Christ?
 - c. How do you personally live out verse 6?
5. Read Galatians 2:20. Describe how Paul lived his life after he was saved by Christ. What would a life lived this way look like? What changes do you need to make or steps could you take to live a more Christ-centered life?
6. Take time to thank the Lord for all He has given us in Christ.
