 - a. Isaiah 42:8
 - b. Romans 11:36
 - c. Revelation 4:11
3. Glory can be defined as praise, honor, worship, or thanksgiving. Who or what do we tend to give glory? What does it look like to authentically give glory to God alone?
4. Pride is when people seek to bring glory to themselves. What does God say about pride?
 - a. Proverbs 16:5
 - b. James 4:6
 - c. Galatians 6:3

1. Even **Creation** exists for His Glory: Ps 19:1; 8:1
2. What is the **Glory** of God?
 - A. His Glory is an **attribute**. Rom 3:23; Neh 9:5; Eph 1:17;
Ps 24:7-10; Acts 7:2
 - B. It is also a **manifestation** of His presence. Ps 57:5;
Ex 24:16-18; 33:18-23;
Jn 1:14; II Cor 4:4-6; Is 40:3-5
3. Jesus’ **mission** was God’s Glory. Jn 17:1-5; 12:27-28; Phil 2:9;
Lk 24:26; I Tim 3:16; Dan 7:14;
Matt 25:31
4. In God’s Glory, we find our **purpose**. Rom 9:23; Is 43:6-7; Rom 8:28
5. God never **shares** the Glory. Is 42:8
6. We are to **live** for His Glory. I Cor 10:31; II Cor 4:4; 3:18;
Eph 3:20-21
