Jesus Unfiltered - Week 5 - The Coming Counselor

1. Share any insights or questions you have from the sermon.
2. Read the Scripture passage from the sermon and discover what you learn about Jesus. Use **some** of the following prompts to help you dig into the passage:
 - a. What emotions, responses, questions or actions do you see from Jesus?
 - b. What does Jesus teach?
 - c. Was there an opportunity for Jesus to sin? If so, what did he do instead?
 - d. How does Jesus treat people?
 - e. How does Jesus relate to God the Father? God the Holy Spirit?
 - f. How would you describe Jesus' character from this passage?
 - g. Anything else you learn about Jesus?
3. How does knowing Jesus unfiltered:
 - a. Help you love him more?
 - b. Compel you to live differently?
 - c. Create a desire to share him with others?
4. Ask the Lord to transform you to be more like Jesus and for opportunities to share Jesus with others.

- I. The disciples' mission is bigger than themselves. Jn 14:1; 16:4b-6, 22
 - A. He has not fully revealed His **departure**. Jn 13:33; 3:36-37; 14:5
 - B. He has not fully revealed their **mission**.
- II. A disciples' mission requires supernatural help. Jn 16:7
 - A. Truth #1: The Holy Spirit is a **Person** not an impersonal force. Rom 8:27; I Cor 12:11; Gal 5:22-23; Jn 14:16
 - B. Truth #2: The Holy Spirit is God not a **creation** of God. I Cor 2:10-12; Jn 1:1-3; 14:17; 15:5; Rom 5:5; 8:9-11; I Jn 4:13
- III. The Holy Spirit has His own **mission**: Jn 15:26f
 - A. He convicts the **world**.
 - B. The Spirit **convicts** the world in 3 ways: Jn 16:8-11
 1. The Holy Spirit convicts of **sin**. Jn 3:17-21
 2. The Holy Spirit convicts of **righteousness**. Jn 16:8; Rom 10:3; Phil 3:9; Titus 3:5; Is 64:5; I Jn 3:5
 3. The Holy Spirit convicts of **judgement**. Jn 16:8; 12:31; 14:30; I Pet 5:8; Heb 2:14; Rev 20:1, 10; Acts 17:30-31
 - C. The Holy Spirit will **guide** the disciples into truth.
 1. The Spirit **continues** what Jesus began. Jn 16:12
 2. The Spirit **speaks** on behalf of the Father. Jn 16:13b
 3. The Spirit is our **guide**. Jn 16:13; 14:26; Ps 119:176
 4. The Spirit **declares** the truth. Jn 16:14-16
 - D. The Spirit seeks to **glorify** the Son. Jn 16:14-15
