DISCUSSION

1. Read Philippians 4:10-13. Verse 13 is often quoted, but the context in verses 11-12 indicates a specific thing Paul can do through Christ. What is it?
2. a) Discuss the "secret" referred to in v. 12. Consider John 14:27, Matthew 6:31-33, and John 15:7-10.
b) Describe a time when this secret was a reality for you.
3. Read Philippians 4:14-18.
a) What "account" is Paul referring to in v. 17? Also see Luke 12:33-34.
b) Why is this account significant? See Matthew 25:34-46.
4. In Philippians 4:19, Paul indicates God will supply all the needs of those who give. Recount a time when this happened to you.
5. Paul concludes this passage by glorifying God in v. 20. What is significant about this?

6. Determine a strategy in how you will commit to participate in the Cultivate campaign and share your plan with members of your small group as an act of accountability.
