DISCUSSION

1. Look at 2 Corinthians 5:10, which introduces this week's passage. In what way will our actions as believers be judged?
2. Read 2 Corinthians 5:11 and 14. What in us is the source of our desire to share Christ with others?
3. Read v. 13. Why do you think some non-Christians may think we are "out of our mind"? How should we respond to that? See 1 Corinthians 2:6-8.
4. Read 2 Corinthians 5:15. What does it look like to live for Christ rather than for ourselves?
5. Read v. 16. How does the world regard people? How do Christians regard people?
6. Read v. 17. As a believer, what is different in the way that you are living out your life today, compared with your life as a non-Christian?
7. Read vv. 18-21. What does it mean that we've been given the ministry of reconciliation?
8. How have you been an ambassador for Christ?

APPLICATION

9. Since we are each appointed as ambassadors of Christ, we seek to represent our Lord accurately. What action will you take this week to further His mission?
