

Family Time Questions Luke 19:28-48

- 1. What transportation did Jesus use to enter Jerusalem?
- 2. What was Jesus' purpose in going to Jerusalem?
- 3. What was Jesus' mission? Read Luke 19:10

Family Discussion

- 1. Jesus was entering as a humble King of peace. Traditionally, entering the city on a **donkey** symbolizes arrival in peace, rather than as a war-waging king arriving on a horse.
- 2. The name Jerusalem means city or foundation of peace.
 - a. Embracing Jesus as King brings peace
 - b. Rejecting Jesus as King brings destruction.

Suggested Activity

• Pretend that you and your family are participating in a parade. Being creative, do a reenactment of the grand entrance to Jerusalem and have your kids yell "Hosanna, hosanna blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord" "Jesus is King"!

Main Point

- Jesus' mission is to save and we have the opportunity to be a part of His mission accepting Him as the King of Kings.
 - That mission will bring division
 - That mission requires <u>reform</u>

Pray: Dear God, help us receive Jesus as King and to gladly be a part of His mission reforming our lives, so we can have peace with You. In Jesus' name, Amen!
