

## SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

### IMAGO DEI: AND THE MISSIO DEI

1. Read Genesis 11:1-9. What reasons do the people give for building the tower in verse 4? How do these reasons given by the Babylonians go against what God has commanded humans to do?
2. Why do you think people “settle” into a life lived for “self” and “security” rather than an aim to serve the purposes of God?
3. What are some of the underlying fears that drive people to want to make a name for themselves?
4. What does it look like when someone seeks their security in the “city of man” [in wealth, technology, medicine, etc.]? How have you seen people come awake to the limitedness of these things and look into the promises of God?
5. God could have simply destroyed the city and tower. Why did he choose to confuse the people’s language instead?
6. Have you ever built a “tower” or structure for yourself only to have it shattered by God? What happened?
7. If you are a Christian, are you moving in mission? How have you recently been moving outward into the world with the gospel?
8. Based on the sermon and discussion, how do you think God wants to sharpen your “aim” for his purposes and plans? How has God been able to bring your “aim” back in focus in the past?

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
