1. What stood out to you from Sunday's message? Did God lay anything specific on your heart? Were you prompted to any specific action?
2. Make some observations about the people in the story.
 - a. Who are Peter and John? What events have helped them be prepared for this moment? Why are they going to the temple and why is that important?
 - b. What do we learn about the beggar? What details about his life matter to the story? What's the difference between what he was asking for and what he received?
 - c. What about the witnesses? What are to we make of their response to the miracle?
3. Who do you identify with in the story the most?
The disciples (Peter & John)? The crippled man? The onlookers? Explain.
4. What are you praying for right now and how would you like God to answer? Do you believe that God is both willing and able to meet your needs
5. This passage challenges us to be mindful of how God is leading and to share what we have been given (the Gospel and the power of the Spirit). How can we be mindful of how God is leading us? How we are we looking to share what we have been given?

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
