Small Group Questions on Matthew 18:21-35

1. Is it easier for you to forgive or ask for forgiveness from someone else? Explain.
2. From this parable, what is the main idea for dealing with someone who has wronged you? What is our motivation?
3. How do you think Peter felt about Jesus' answer to his question?
4. How do you think forgiveness, mercy, and humility are related?
5. Think of a time when you were in need of someone else's forgiveness. Think of a time when you needed to forgive someone. How did you feel in both circumstances?
6. How much money did the servant owe his master? How much money did the fellow servant owe the first servant? What is the difference? Similarly, what is the difference between the debt you owe God and the debt others owe you?
7. How easy or hard is it for you to ask the Lord for forgiveness? How easy or hard is it for you to extend forgiveness to others?
8. Is the master's response in verse 34 too harsh? Why or why not? How does this affect how we read verse 35 and the judgment of God?
9. Think of someone in your life who needs your forgiveness. Make a plan for how you will extend generous forgiveness to that person this week.

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
