

## SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

Small Group Questions on 2 Corinthians 8:1-9

1. Have you ever witnessed a time when someone, out of their extreme poverty, gave generously to another? Share about that experience.
2. Why does Paul call the collection of the Macedonians an act of "grace?"  
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3. The word "sharing" in verse 4 is the Greek word "Koinonia", often translated as "fellowship". Paul sees fellowship as partnering together for the Gospel. Why do you think he sees generous giving as a part of that? See Philippians 1:5;4:15 for another example.
4. How did Jesus become poor? How does his poverty make you rich? How does the Gospel compel us to live generously?
5. What excuses do people often give for why they cannot give generously? What valid excuses do Christians have for not giving generously?
6. Why is the act of giving generously so important for believers?
7. Rate yourself, as you are right now, from 1 to 10 in the area of "Sacrificial Generosity." What is one step you can take this week to improve?
8. Give the members of your small group time to pray to God and ask how he is calling them to be generous. If you have married couples in the group, they can pray and discuss that together.

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
